The Barenaked Ladies, also known as BNL, was started 1988 by Ed Robertson and former member Steven Page. By 1990, Barenaked Ladies went from a duo to a full band. Current and former band members Ed Robertson, Kevin Hearn, Jim Creegan, Tyler Stewart, Andy Creegan and Steven Page all met from music camp, music school, or just playing music in the Toronto- Scarborough area. For 20 years, the group has been putting on shows, but it's not just all about the music: They have worked hard on giving back to their community and the environment. They are currently one of the few touring acts whose tour bus runs on bio-diesel fuel.

Barenaked Ladies released their first full album, *Gordon*, in 1992, which turned out to be a huge success. Their hit single, "Shoe Box," from the band's third album, *Born on a Pirate Ship*, was featured on the soundtrack for the popular TV sitcom Friends. The group won their first Juno Award— Canada's version of the Grammy— as Group of the year in 1993. In 1999, their song, "One Week" was nominated in the category of Best Pop Performance by Duo or Group. The music video was nominated for an MTV Video Music Award for Best Art Direction. In 2001, the band was nominated for a Grammy for "Pinch Me" and they also won three more Juno Awards for Maroon under Best Pop Album, Best Album and Best Group.

Rising star Caitlin Crosby will also be performing. Crosby's self-titled debut album deals with several serious issues such as homelessness, peer pressure, as well as Hollywood's obsession with body image. With her deep vocals, thought-provoking lyrics and edgy, pop melodies, Crosby provides a fresh, new voice that demands to be heard.
