

# ACTIVITIES

## Grades K-2

The following activities are designed to give you ideas to use with your class before and after your visit to the Fresno Fair. The activities can be integrated into your curriculum, used as mini-lessons, or incorporated into a unit if it works with what you are teaching.

## MATH

### PRE/POST-FAIR

1. Teach shapes using natural items such as: round - orange, peach, cabbage; oval - olive, grape, lemon; and triangle - strawberry.
2. Sets. Using beans or seeds, have children group items into sets. For example, ask them to make (5) sets of 2, (3) sets of 3, etc.



### POST-FAIR

1. Many simple graphs may be used after your visit to the fair. You might wish to have students vote on, and then graph such things as favorite animal, best agricultural display, etc.
2. Count seeds in various types of fruit. Older students can use fruit segments to illustrate fractions.
