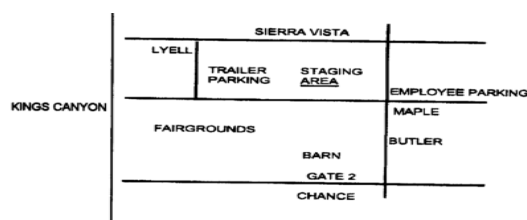

GENERAL RULES

ELIGIBILITY: Open to residents & producers of the State of California, unless specified.

POULTRY INSPECTIONS: The Fair is mandated, by the CA Dept. of Food & Agriculture, to do poultry inspections prior to coop in. The inspections will be conducted by a certified poultry inspector. Inspections will be held in the livestock staging area located on the north east corner of Maple and Butler. There will be a tent set up where exhibitors will need to check in and have the birds inspected.

STAGING AREA



All exhibitors must have their birds inspected.

Once the birds are *cleared* by the inspector, exhibitors may proceed to the Gate 2 entrance of the fair located on Chance Ave. The Fur and Feathers loading zone will be on the north side of the northwest corner of the livestock barns (the new home of Fur and Feathers). Exhibitors will be cleared to park there to coop in. Vehicles must be moved *immediately* after your birds are cooped.

RULES: Rules, definitions and judging procedures as prescribed in appropriate rule books shall apply to all district and county Fairs, provided they do not conflict with any other rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture. In the case of rabbits this shall be the Guide Book and Standard of the American Rabbit Breeder's Assn., Inc.; in poultry, the **official** Show Rules and the Standard of Perfection of the American Poultry Assn., Inc.; in pigeons the Book of Pigeon Standards. The 2009 ARBA Convention will be held in San Diego, Ca on Oct. 30 thru Nov. 4. Where no American standard is in vogue, the latest European standard will be used.

IDENTIFICATION: All species **must** be appropriately identified, i.e. permanent left ear markings for rabbits & covies; leg bands for poultry; serially numbers &/or current year seamless leg band of correct size for young pigeons & older pigeons must have either seamless or split prior year serially numbered bands.

These identifications must conform to the entry form on arrival at show. Any duplication of identifications by one exhibitor in the same division must be eliminated and the change recorded on the judging sheet before judging.

A limited number of bands for poultry may be available at a cost of \$.50 each. Check with Fur & Feathers 559 253-7153 before receive date.

EXCUSE FROM COMPETITION: A judge may eliminate (excuse) an exhibit from competition because of temporary or curable defects but the entry will be counted.

ENTRY FORMS & FEES: Entry forms furnished by the Big Fresno Fair must be filled out in detail including all requested information. Additional entry forms will be mailed upon request.

No exhibit will be cooped unless entry fee is paid in advance.

ALL ANIMALS MUST BE IDENTIFIED IN DIVISIONS WHERE SPECIFIED. (I.E. VARIETY, COLOR, BREED).

SEPARATE ENTRY FORMS: Each of the following requires its own entry form: Rabbits, Large Poultry, Bantams, Turkeys, Ducks, Geese, Pheasants, & Pigeons.

MULTIPLE CASH AWARDS: No exhibitor shall receive more than two cash awards in any one class. State Rule VI-6 applies.

DECORATIONS: Ribbons and trophies won at other shows may not be displayed on coops either as decoration or advertising. Other signs or placards will not be acceptable. After completion of judging, an owner may offer an exhibit for sale by indicating a price on the coop card. Other signs or placards will not be acceptable.

DISEASE: NO DISEASED ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. Please examine animals carefully before bringing to the show.

FEEDING & GROOMING TIMES: Exhibitors may feed & groom their animals from **7 AM to 8:30 AM and 7 PM to 8:00 PM. NO EXCEPTIONS.** No extended parking available. Feed passes will be available if you need to bring feed inside the Fairgrounds.

OWN RISK: All entries are entered at owner's risk. The management assumes no responsibility for theft, damage, injury, etc. The management reserves the right to refuse an entry which is not in the best interest of the Fur and Feathers Department of the Big Fresno Fair.

SANCTIONED: The rabbit show is sanctioned by the American Rabbit Breeders Assn., Inc. The poultry show is sanctioned by the American Poultry Assn., Inc. and the American Bantam Association.

PIGEON COLORS: ONLY RECOGNIZED COLORS for pigeons shall be considered in "Any other Color" (AOC) divisions.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Substitutions will *only* be allowed within the same class and **only two per exhibitor.**

FEEDERS: Exhibitors may supply their own crocks and/or feeders and will be responsible for them.

TRAFFIC: To check on traffic before you leave home call 650-3292. We don't want anyone to wait in traffic. We need every exhibitor's help. When unloading is completed, remove your vehicle from the grounds. *If we all work together, we can help to overcome any traffic concerns.*

UNLOADING: Rabbit exhibitors may unload rabbits **only** through Gate 2.

WATER BOTTLES: Exhibitors may bring 2 water bottles per entry for freezing. The bottles will be placed in cages to help keep rabbits cool.

OFFICE: The Fur & Feathers Office will be in the old Exhibit Office in the Livestock Pavilion.

OWNERSHIP: Exhibitors must own animal exhibited the entire 60 days before the fair.

PASSES: For pass information refer to Livestock section of the Fair handbook.

STATE RULES: All state rules apply – see section 2 of handbook.

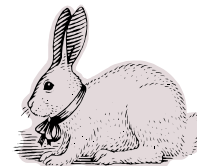
