RULES

NO GLASS ALLOWED

ENTRY FORMS: Use the "special group" entry form located in back of exhibitor's handbook. Entry forms will NOT be accepted by fax.

ELIGIBILITY: All high school art students in Fresno County.

AWARDS: All awards are confidential until October 6, 2010. Failure to do so will result in disqualification. Results will NOT be given over the telephone.

ORIGINAL WORK: All work MUST be selected and submitted by the high school art teacher, who verifies by submission that all work is ORIGINAL, not copies from published photographs or other artwork.

COMPLETION OF WORK: All projects must have been completed within the last 12 months preceding the fair by students in grades 9, 10, 11, and 12, plus those who graduated last June.

MATTING: All work must be matted or framed in neutral colors, (white, grey, black, beige, brown, or cream). **No glass accepted.**

HANGING: All exhibits **MUST** have a complete secure backing and a wire/hanger on the MAT OR FRAME. **Any improperly prepared pictures will be rejected.**

SUBSTITUTIONS: There will be no substitutions allowed.

ENTERING MULTIPLE DIVISIONS: A student cannot have work entered in the H.S. Art and the Junior Fine Arts/Photography Divisions. Duplicate items cannot be entered in the Open Art Building.

TRANSFERING TO DIFFERENT CLASS: Work can only be transferred from one class to another by the judge. Work entered in the wrong class may be disqualified.

LIMITATION: Team Teachers are limited to 10 entries per team.

EXHIBIT LABELING: Work must have students name & school on back of each piece of art.

HANGING OF ART: Begins at 8:30 September 24, 2010

2. Drawing (colored pencil, felt markers, pastel, oil pastel.
3. Drawing, Black & White, pen & ink or black felt markers
4. Painting, Transparent, Acrylic paint or watercolors.
5. Painting, Opaque, Oil, tempera or acrylic paint
6. Ceramic, casting and painted or glazed
7. Ceramic, sculpture
8. Ceramic, pottery, functional pieces
9. Photography - classic/straight (film or digital)
10. Photography-manipulated/altered
11. Two-Dimensional Design (computer generated art)
12. Two-Dimensional Design (print making, graphic design, collage, mixed media. Not photos.
