## ROSE SHOW RULES

1. This show is organized and judged in accordance with the rules of the American Rose Society as specified in the American Rose Society "Guideline for Judging Roses."
2. The San Joaquin Valley Rose Society is an open show. Membership in the American Rose Society or the San Joaquin Valley Rose Society is not necessary to exhibit. *All roses* entered in this show must have been grown in the exhibitor's outdoor private garden.
3. Only one person or team from one garden may enter any one class. Multiple entries of the same variety in the same class will be disqualified. Classes 1-18 can have multiple entries of different varieties of rose. Class 19-24 (Challenge Classes) are limited to one entry per person or team.
4. During judging, no one will be allowed in the judging area except judges, clerks, and the Show Committee.
5. Roses do not have to be registered. Rose varieties and exhibition names will be determined by *Modern Roses*,

*International Rose Registrations* and its supplements to date, *The American Rose Magazine*, the *ARS Handbook for Selecting Roses*, the *ARS Handbook of Approved Exhibition Names*, and the *Combined Rose List*. *All entries must be entered under the ARS official exhibition name.* When there is a conflict between *The Combined Rose List* and ARS publications, ARS Publications will be the final authority)

6. Classification of all roses by color and type shall be accordance with ARS publications to the date of the show. The current *Handbook for Selecting Roses* is the general guide.
7. Judging shall be done by ARS Accredited Judges who may be assisted by Apprentice Judges.
8. Only official ARS entry tags may be used in making entries. No exhibitor number is needed. The top portion of the entry tag needs to be completely filled out. The bottom portion of the entry tag only needs the exhibitor's name.
9. Judges may make or withhold awards, including ribbons, based on the merit of the exhibit. The decision of the judges is final. Judging shall be in accordance with the current *Guidelines for Judging Roses*.
10. No exhibits may be removed before the close of the show except by the Show Committee.
11. All ribbons and ARS certificates will be awarded at the next meeting of the San Joaquin Valley Rose Society, Tuesday, October 19, 2010.
12. Horticultural entries shall be disqualified for:
  - Misnamed, misclassified, unlabeled or mislabeled
  - Stem-on-stem, except Old Garden Roses and Shrubs
  - Presence of a foreign substance applied to the foliage, stem or bloom to improve the appearance of the specimen
  - Side buds or buds on a specimen that must be shown without side buds
  - A specimen in violation of ARS rules or local Society rules applying to this show

13. Penalization of entries may be applied for:
- Unwanted side growth, side buds, and/or spent blooms removed to improve the appearance of the specimen is subject to a penalty to the degree of the impairment
  - Stem length must have a pleasing relation to the size of the bloom
14. Wedging material may be used to position a specimen in a container. If the wedging material protrudes above the lip on the container the specimen shall be penalized to the degree of distraction.
15. Entries in any class calling for one bloom per stem must be shown without side buds. They may have been disbudded manually or may have been grown naturally without side buds. Climbing sports must be exhibited with their bush counterparts.
16. In most cases, an exhibition bloom is considered at its most perfect phase of possible beauty when it is from 1/2 to 3/4 open with sufficient petals symmetrically arranged in an attractive circular outline tending toward a high center.

One Classic Shrub Rose, (defined as Hybrid Rugosa, Kordeesii, Hybrid Moyesii and Hybrid Musk in the most current *Handbook for Selecting Roses* are eligible); 1 bloom per stem or 1 spray, 2 or more blooms ½ or more open. *Blue ribbon winners from this class will be eligible for Best Classic Shrub Certificate*  
A. Any Color
7. One Large Flowered Climber, 1 bloom per stem OR 1 spray, 2 or more blooms ½ or more open.  
*Blue ribbon winners in this class will be eligible for the ARS Best Climber Certificate*  
A. Any Color
8. One polyantha rose, 1 bloom per stem OR 1 spray, 2 or more blooms ½ or more open.  
Blue ribbon winners from this class will be eligible for the *ARS Best Polyantha Certificate*  
A. Any Color
9. One Old Garden Rose, as defined in the most current *Handbook for Selecting Roses*; 1 bloom per stem OR 1 spray, 2 or more blooms ½ or more open. **Date of origin MUST appear on the entry tag.**
  - A. Cultivars introduced before 1867 and after, any color Blue ribbon winners from this class will be eligible for the *ARS Dowager Queen Certificate*
  - B. Cultivars introduced 1867 and after, any color Blue ribbon winners from this class will be eligible for the *ARS Victorian Rose Certificate*
10. Any unnamed rose, any type of rose, 1 bloom per stem OR 1 Spray, 2 or more blooms ½ or more open, any color. (Judges will try to identify the variety)
11. One Miniature rose, 1 bloom per stem.  
*Blue ribbon winners in this class will be eligible for Miniature Queen of the Show*

15. Most Fragrant Rose (any type), 1 bloom per stem OR 1 spray, 2 or more blooms ½ or more open.  
*Blue ribbon winners in this class will be eligible for ARS Most Fragrant Rose Certificate*  
A. Any Color
16. One fully open rose of any type, stamens must be showing, 1 bloom per stem.  
*Blue ribbon winners in this class will be eligible for ARS Best Open Bloom Certificate*  
A. Any Color
17. One bloom of a single petal rose (4-8 petals), 1 bloom per stem, any large type of rose-hybrid tea, grandiflora, large flowered climber, shrub, OGR or floribunda *Blue ribbon winners in this class will be eligible for ARS Best Large Rose Single Petal Bloom Certificate.*

18. One spray of a single petal rose (4-8) petals, 2 or more blooms at least ½ or more open, any type of rose.

## CHALLENGE CLASSES

19. Rose in a Bowl-One hybrid tea, grandiflora, floribunda or shrub bloom. A rose in exhibition stage (bloom should be about ½ open) with no foliage, floating in a bowl of water, stem must not touch the bottom of the bowl. *Best of Class will receive the ARS Rose in a Bowl Certificate*
20. Rose in a Bowl-One Miniature Bloom. A miniature rose in exhibition stage (bloom should be about ½ open) with no foliage, floating in a bowl of water, stem must not touch the bottom of the bowl. *Best of Class will receive the ARS Miniature Rose in a Bowl Certificate*
21. A collection of three stems of roses, one bloom per stem, no side buds, any type of rose.
22. A collection of three sprays of roses, 2 or more blooms at least ½ open per spray, any type of rose.
23. English Box-Hybrid tea, grandiflora, floribunda or shrub roses in exhibition stage. One type of rose per box (six hybrid tea, or grandiflora or floribundas or shrub roses). Blooms should be about ½ open to ¾ open. Six blooms with no side buds and no foliage placed in a box in vials of water, any combinations of colors. *Best of Class will receive the ARS Best English Box Certificate*
24. English Box-Miniature roses. Six miniature blooms in exhibition stage (blooms should be about ½ open to ¾ open) with no side buds and no foliage placed in a box in vials of water, any combinations of colors. *Best of Class will receive the ARS Best Miniature English Box Certificate*

## NOVICE CLASSES

The Novice Class is open to anyone who has not entered in an American Rose Society Show. *The Best Novice entry will receive the ARS Best Novice Certificate.*

28. Any other type of rose, 1 bloom per stem OR 1 Spray, 2 or more blooms ½ or more open, any color. Unnamed roses may be entered in this class. Judges will try to identify the variety.

## JUDGES INVITATIONAL CLASSES

Judges judging this show, no restrictions on number of entries.

29. *All blue ribbon winners in each section will be eligible for the ARS Judges Certificate.*

- A. One hybrid tea or grandiflora bloom, one bloom per stem, no side buds, in exhibition form.
- B. One Floribunda, one bloom per stem, no side buds OR one spray, 2 or more blooms ½ or more open.
- C. One Miniature/Miniflora, one bloom, no side buds OR 1 spray, 2 or more blooms ½ or more open.
- D. One Shrub, one bloom OR 1 spray, 2 or more blooms ½ or more open.
- E. One Old Garden Rose, one bloom OR 1 spray, any variety, date of origin must appear on entry tag.
- F. Any other rose not listed, one bloom, no side buds OR 1 spray, 2 or more blooms ½ or more open. (example: large flowered climbers, polyanthas)
